Humberside DAB transmitter launch and frequency change - August 31st /1st September

Pure Support - UK - 2019-05-20 - in DAB Specific

The frequency change is from 11B to 10D and will start at 22:00 on Wednesday 31st August to be completed by 06:00 on Thursday 1st September 2016.

This frequency change won't affect people who are listening on FM, MW, online or via digital television. This is a DAB frequency change only.

The stations affected are **Absolute Classic Rock, Absolute Radio 90s, BBC Radio Humberside, Capital, Gold, Kiss Fresh, Smooth, Viking FM, Viking 2 and Viking 3.**

Listeners on DAB digital radio in Humberside will need to retune their DAB digital radio on the morning of Thursday 1st September to continue to listen to local services on DAB digital radio, or to pick them up for the first time.

Retuning a DAB digital radio is a simple process. Simply press the auto tune or auto scan button on your DAB digital radio or go into the menu and press auto tune. If this does not restore all services, then listeners are recommended to run a full scan on their DAB digital radio.

Listeners who use their DAB digital radio as an alarm clock set to local services are advised to use a different alarm system to wake up to on Thursday 1st September
