Notes for customers recording on the Evoke F4 with Bluetooth and Sensia 200D Connect

When purchasing a USB stick to perform recordings there are a few things to be aware of.

Our products support recording to USB sticks - up to 8GB in size. We only support USB flash drives and not external hard drives.

Please note if you do use larger capacity sticks such a 64GB you may encounter inconsistent behavior because this size stick is not officially supported

We suggest formatting your USB stick before using it in your radio

The Evoke F4 and Sensia 200D support FAT32 file structure and any USB stick being used in the radio needs to be formatted to the FAT32 structure.

You can record, digital radio or a Pure Connect station. Please note that if you set up a custom station and record this, this stream does not pass through the Pure stream checker. This means the station is not a validated stream as the non-custom stations are. As the stream cannot be validated you may encounter inconsistent behavior with the recording.

Note: NTFS is not supported.
